membership code of conduct



Contribute proactively to a clean energy future for Australia by demonstrating sustainable practices.

Demonstrate commitment to best practice and continual improvement of the industry including participation in voluntary guidelines and accreditations.

Conduct business generally in accordance with the laws and regulations of the states of operation.

Compete fairly in the markets of operation.

Work safely and apply industry best practice to the health, safety and wellbeing of employees, clients, suppliers and communities.

Aim to bring long-term benefits to the industry, rather than short-term advantage for individuals.

Cooperate with and support the Clean Energy Council to achieve its corporate objectives.

Show respect for a diverse range of people and cultures and for their human rights.

Not be involved in corrupt practices, bribery, discrimination or similiar improper behaviour.

Refrain from making representations (media, government, other) on behalf of the Clean Energy Council.

Act ethically and with integrity, decency and respect for the community and the environment.

Perform and comply with any variation or amendments to the Code of conduct made at any time by the Clean Energy Council.
